

## Yuma Catholic High School Presents: 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual Rachel Determan Memorial Rib Cook-Off

## 2025 Rules Team Rules:

- 1. The entry fee will be \$150.00 per team if registered before 11-07-25 or \$200 after.
- 2. Entry form must be received by November 21st to be included in the event program.
- 3. Yuma Catholic (YC) will furnish 6 cases (72 racks) of ribs to each team and charcoal by request (see reverse side). All ribs must be served to the event patrons.
- 4. Entrants will provide everything needed to cook and serve their ribs. Don't forget cooking supplies, sunshade, grills, extra charcoal, sauces, cooking utensils, serving and cooking extra tables, chairs and please feel free to be creative with decorating your booth for the event. **NO power will be available.**We will provide you with 2 8' tables for serving.
- 5. Entrants may use any type of sauce(s), cooking method(s), or fuel they choose.
- 6. ALL ribs must be cooked on site (at your booth) using the ribs provided by YC.
- 7. Entrants must offer a side dish of their choosing. The cost of each rib and/or side dish is one ticket punch which is pre-purchased or purchased at the door. YC will provide a ticket punch volunteer for your booth.
- 8. A **5** rib per person (in line) limit will be enforced at all team booths. A non-competitive team will be cooking ribs in mass to serve individuals wanting additional ribs or full racks.
- 9. Teams will be able to pick up your full allotment of cases of ribs at 5am (the day of the contest), if you do not pick them up at the US. Foods truck, they will be delivered to your space at 6am. Ribs and side dishes should be delivered to the judging station by a team member of your choice at your assigned time. Rib delivery will begin at 11:00am and continue every 15 minutes until all teams have submitted their ribs and side dishes. 6 separate containers with one rib and side dish must be provided for our judges. Team Leaders will be notified the week of the event of their delivery time and location. Booths must be manned from 10:45 a.m.-3:00 p.m. Tear down may begin at 3:15 p.m. Disassembly and clean-up must be completed by 6:00 p.m.
- 10. Entrants may begin setting up at noon the day prior to the cook-off. Security will be provided from 12:00 noon until the start of the cook-off. Please let us know if you will be bringing an RV to the event.
- 11. No insurance is provided. Each team must have a fire extinguisher at their booth.
- 12. Entrants are responsible for cleaning their space and removing all their equipment. Do not dump grease or any liquids (other than water) on the grass.
- 13. Do not dump hot coals in trash cans or on site; receptacles will be furnished. **Coal pits must be cleaned out BEFORE you leave.**
